The IFWJ president's nominee on the Central Press Accreditation Committee (Press Information Bureau) and IFWJ Treasurer Com.Shyam Babu attended the first meeting of CPAC at Shastri Bhavan in New Delhi on 6 April and submitted IFWJ proposal for accreditation to online media persons.

Now that a democratically elected government has been formed in Myanmar (Burma) under the leadership of Aung San Sue Chi, the IFWJ plans to renew it visit to Burma. It will be as big as the earlier ones to Nepal and Bhutan. The IFWJ delegation to Kathmandu had included 183 persons for six days visit in November 2011. And 112 persons had joined the IFWJ delegation to Bhutan. IFWJ delegates will leave for Dhaka (Bangladesh) and Yangoon (Burma) from Kolkata airport after the monsoon.
